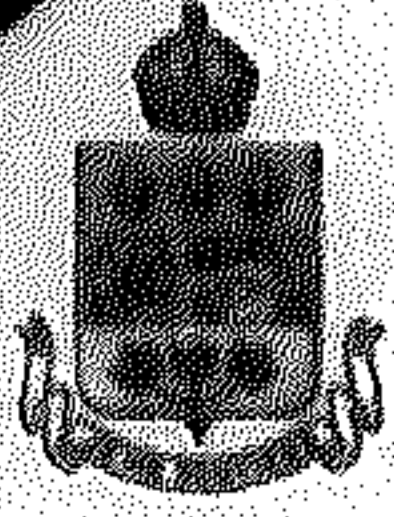

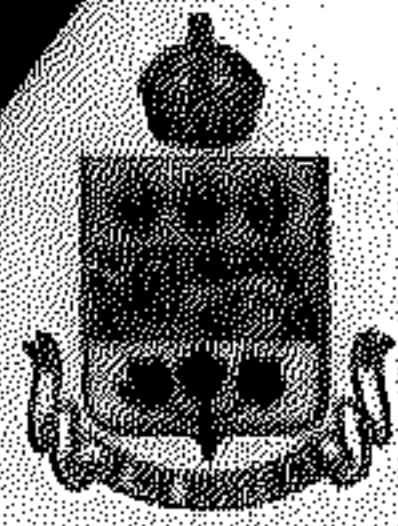

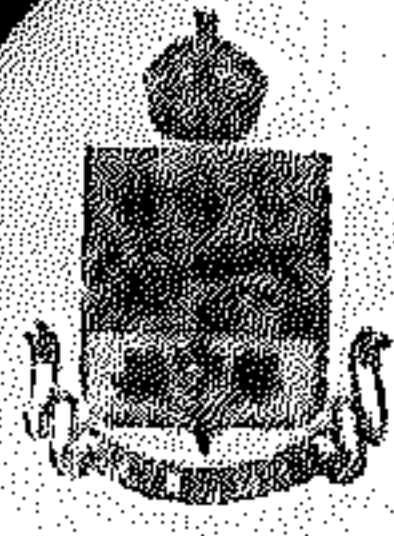

QUEBEC FARMERS' ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

SECTION ONE

NAME:

The name of the association shall be "QUEBEC FARMERS' ASSOCIATION."

SECTION TWO

OBJECTS:

1. To develop and maintain an organization that will be the voice of the English speaking farmers of Quebec.
2. To provide maximum membership participation in policy development and execution.
3. To increase farm income and rural standards of living.
4. To promote and encourage better understanding and exchange of views between agricultural groups and urban business and industrial groups and organizations throughout the Province of Quebec.
5. To co-operate with all farm organizations, government agencies, co-operatives, public officials, business, labour, church and other groups in advancing agriculture and general welfare.
6. To work with the Union Catholique des Cultivateurs and the Co-operative Federee de Quebec for the benefit of all Quebec farmers.
7. To have a representative at all Canadian Federation of Agriculture or other national farm organization meetings.
8. To co-ordinate county and provincial farm organization activities to achieve maximum results.
9. To organize such affiliates as are necessary to carry out the stated principles of this organization.

SECTION THREE

BOUNDARIES:

The Province of Quebec.

SECTION FOUR

ASSESSMENT OR MEMBERSHIP:

Every owner, tenant or operator of farm property within the Province of Quebec upon payment of the annual fee and subject to the approval of the executive may become a member of the Quebec Farmers' Association. The annual fee shall be not less than \$2.50 and not more than \$5.00 per member.

ENTRANCE FEE:

The entrance fee shall be \$1.00.

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
